
# INSTRUCTIONS

## Project: Paint A Pot





### STEP 1

Put down some old newspaper or paper if you have it, to prevent any mess. You could also wear a smock to protect your clothing! Get a small container of water to wash your brush in.



#### STEP 2

Paint some designs on your Terracotta pot. You can use the images on the front of the box as a painting guide. - Wash the paint brush in water between colours and immediately after your design is complete.



#### STEP 3

Place your finished Terracotta pot on top of the Water tray. Fill your pot with soil, leaving a 1cm gap at the top. For best results use a well-drained soil. Ensure your soil is moist by fully drenching with water then allow to drain!

Open the seed packet and carefully empty seedsinto a small spoon or container, for easy sewing.

Spread approximately 5-10 seeds in your pot evenly, and press them down slightly (~2mm). Place on a sunny window sill, or outside in full sun. Keep soil moist, watering when top layer appears dry. Watch your seedlings sprout and grow over the following weeks!

Botanical name: Lobularia maritima

Common name: Alyssum - Carpet of Snow

IDEAL SEED DEPTH: 2mm
IDEAL GERMINATION TEMPERATURE: 18-22°C
GERMINATION TIME: 7-14 days
IDEAL SPACING (OUT OF POT) - 20cm
LIGHT & SOIL REQUIREMENTS - Well drained soil, full or partial sun.
DAYS TO FLOWERING: 60 days



## TIPS

- You can test how well your soil drains by drenching the soil in your pot with water - if the soil takes more than 60 seconds to drain, mix in a few teaspoons of sand or crushed-up dry leaves to improve drainage.
- Any extra seeds can be planted in your garden or given to a friend! If you plant too many seeds in your pot, you may need to thin out your plants later. See thinning instructions below.
- Before your seeds sprout and grow, they need to be protected from wind and heavy rain to have the best chance of growing.
- Thinning if you have too many plants growing closely in a
  pot, they may become crowded and not grow well. You can
  thin out your plants by gently pulling out smaller plants
  when soil is moist, to allow larger plants to grow better.
- Replanting when your plants out grow your pot, you can replant them in the ground simply tap out.
