



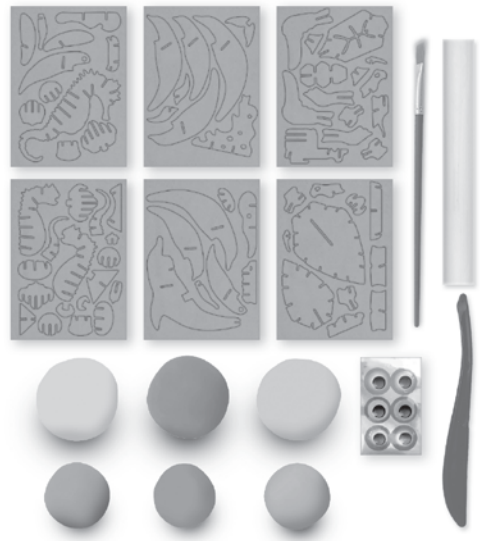

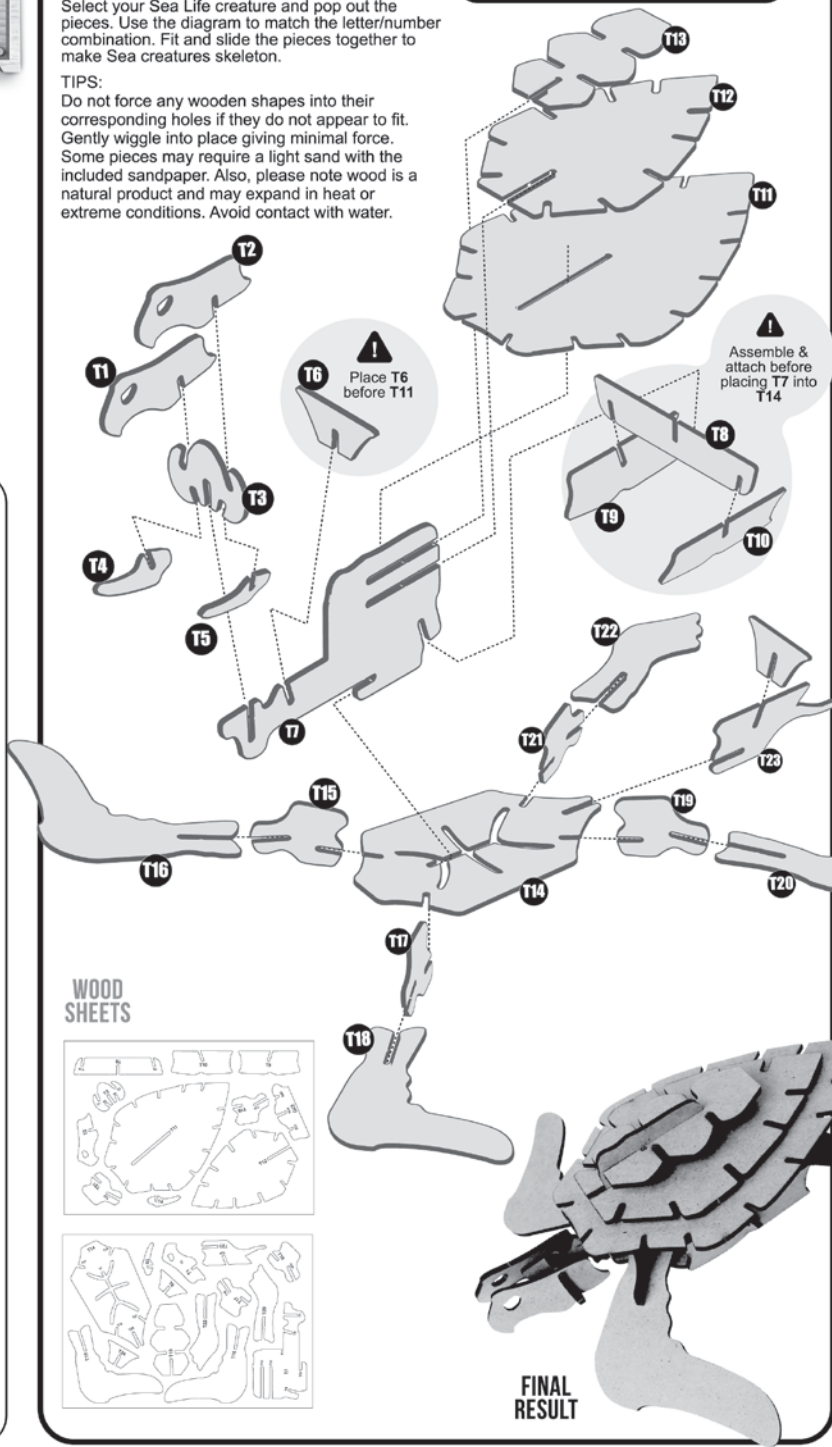


GETTING STARTED

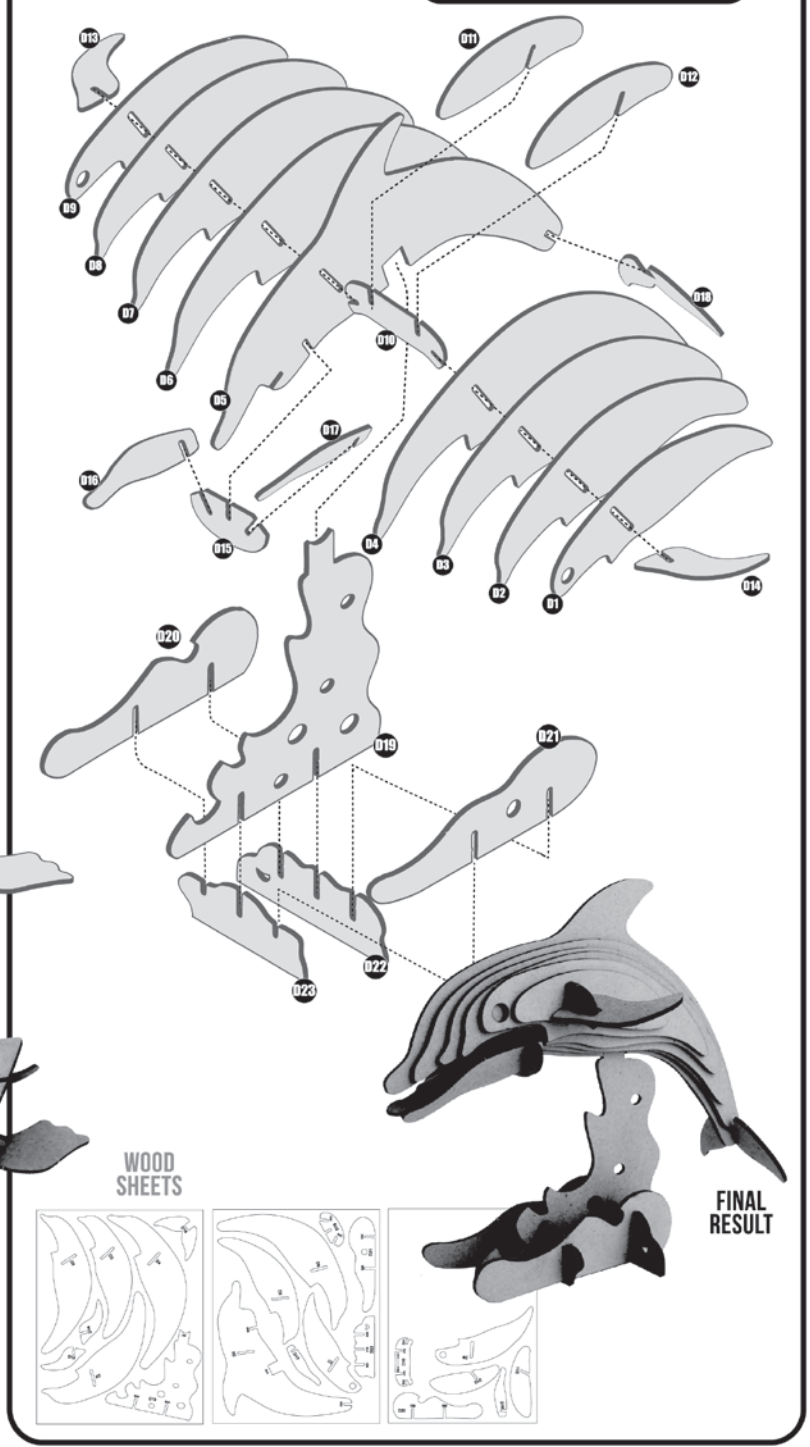
Select your Sea Life creature and pop out the pieces. Use the diagram to match the letter/number combination. Fit and slide the pieces together to make Sea creatures skeleton.

TIPS:
Do not force any wooden shapes into their corresponding holes if they do not appear to fit. Gently wiggle into place giving minimal force. Some pieces may require a light sand with the included sandpaper. Also, please note wood is a natural product and may expand in heat or extreme conditions. Avoid contact with water.

SCULPTING

Now it's time to apply the easy bonding air dry clay! Follow the Sea Life clay skin colours on the front of the box or design your own combinations. Choose one large bag and one small bag colour for each skeleton. The clay will dry out when it has contact with air so ensure you place it back into the bag and seal it when not in use.



1. GETTING STARTED

As an option, you may like to fill any gaps in your creation with some foil. Simply mould the foil into any larger cavities so the clay sits flush over the surface.



2. ROLLING TO MAKE THE SKIN

Take your rolling pin and gently roll out your first clay colour. For best results flatten out clay with hand first, then roll in one direction aiming to create a skin thickness around 2-3mm thick.



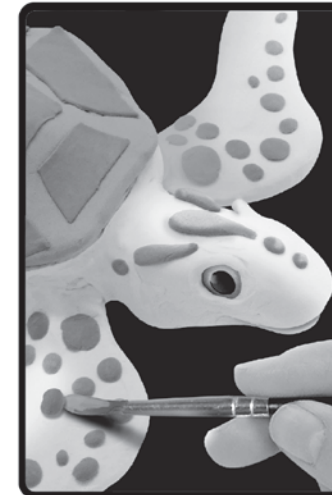
3. APPLYING THE SKIN

After rolling your clay, immediately form it over the wooden skeleton and smooth over. Apply as many layers and colours as you require. Use your sculpting tool to help you smooth over the clay.



4. ADDING FEATURES

Choose your creation's metallic eyes and stick them to the clay. Use your sculpting tool to form raised areas around the brow area, this will give your character more realism. Also try forming spikes and rolling small dots for extra details.



5. FINISHING

Wet your brush to help adhere any clay that is starting to dry out. Simply brush water onto the area, then hold the clay piece in place for 10 seconds and allow to dry. The clay should dry between 6hrs - 8hrs depending on the climate.
