

INSTRUCTIONS

Project: Fairy Garden



Planting Seeds



STEP 1

Firstly scatter a layer of river rocks on the base of your tin planter (keep some spare). Then fill your tin with soil, leaving a 1cm gap at the top. For best results, use a fine, well-drained soil. Ensure you water your soil until it is moist, test this by pushing your fingers into the soil.



STEP 2

Open the seed packet and carefully empty seeds into a small spoon or container for easy sowing.



STEP 3

Spread approximately 5-10 seeds in your pot evenly and press the down slightly (~2mm). Place on a sunny window sill or outside in full sun. Keep soil moist, watering when top layer appears dry.



STEP 4

Watch your seedlings sprout and grow over the following weeks!

Note: Plant growth will vary dependant on climate and growing conditions.

Plaster Fairies



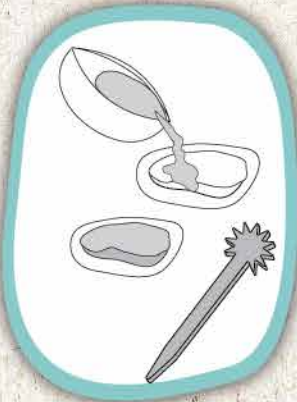
STEP 1

First put down some old newspaper to prevent mess. Wear a smock to protect clothing.



STEP 2

Using a mixing bowl, pour in the plaster powder. Gradually add water while stirring with a stirrer to form a paste consistency, stir the plaster quickly so it blends easily.



STEP 3

Quickly pour the plaster into the moulds in the trays so it fills the moulding shapes to the top. Use the pop stick to smooth the plaster. Tap the trays on a hard surface to remove air bubbles. Whilst still wet, place a stake (found on the wood sheet) in each fairy. Don't push the stake too far into the plaster! Allow 24 hours to dry. Drying times may vary - make sure the plaster feels dry!



STEP 4

Once dry, gently tap the outside of the tray and slide the fairies out. Be careful when handling them as not to break them! Paint the fairies any way you like! Be creative! Allow to dry. Create a unique magical fairy garden scene by adding colour to the rocks and other plaster pieces.

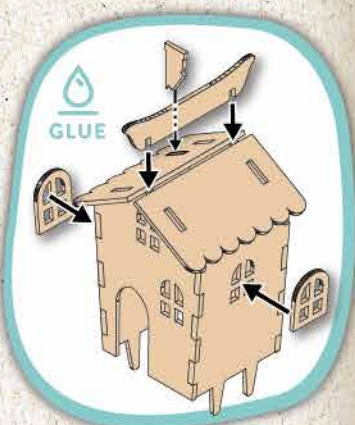

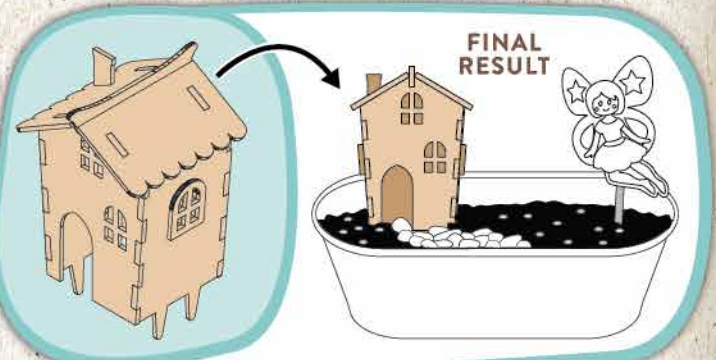

Planting information

Common name:	CAT GRASS
Botanical name:	Dactylis glomerata
Ideal seed depth:	2mm
Ideal germination temperature:	20-30°C
Germination time:	5-10 days
Ideal seed spacing:	Can be densely planted
Light & soil requirements:	Moist well drained soil, full or partial sun
Days to flowering:	20-30 days
Common name:	BALSAM - Tom Thumb mix
Botanical name:	Impatiens balsamina
Ideal seed depth:	6mm
Ideal germination temperature:	22-26°C
Germination time:	14-21 days
Ideal seed spacing:	35cm
Light & soil requirements:	Moist well drained soil, full or partial sun
Days to flowering:	85 days

- The seed should be scattered on the top of a fine seed raising mix soil and do not cover the seed.
- Ensure that the soil doesn't contain wood bark as this will dry out the seeds and stop them from germinating.

TIPS

- Any extra seeds can be planted in your garden or given to a friend! If you plant too many seeds in your pot, you may need to thin out your plants later. See thinning instructions below.
- Before your seeds sprout and grow, they need to be protected from wind and heavy rain to have the best chance of growing.
- Thinning - if you have too many plants growing closely in a pot, they may become crowded and not grow well. You can thin out your plants by gently pulling out smaller plants when soil is moist, to allow larger plants to grow better.
- Replanting - when your plants out grow your pot, you can replant them in the ground - simply tap out.

CAUTION: Keep out of reach of young children. Keep away from food, drink and animals. When using glue and paint, ensure carpets, clothes and furniture are protected. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. In case of contact with eyes, rinse immediately with plenty of water and seek medical advice immediately and show this label. Please remove all packaging attachments before giving to child. Not suitable for children under 3 years!

Do not place plaster in mouth. Do not inhale dust or powder. Do not apply to the body. Dust may irritate eyes, nose and throat.

Do not eat seeds or any part of the plant. Plant photo for reference only, results vary depending on growing conditions. Seeds packed locally in Australia.

Adult supervision required. Retain this package for future reference. Colour and shape of contents may vary.
