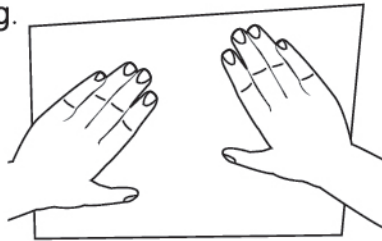


## MOSAIC STEPPING STONES

### Instructions

**STEP 1.** First put down some old newspaper to prevent mess. Wear a smock to protect clothing.



**STEP 2.** Using a large mixing bowl or bucket, pour in half the cement powder. Gradually add water while mixing with the stirring stick to form a runny paste-like consistency, stir the cement quickly so it blends easily. Keep adding cement and water gradually, until you have used all the cement powder.



**STEP 3.** Empty the cement mixture into mould and use the stirring stick to spread the mixture out.

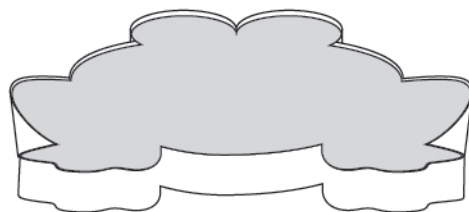
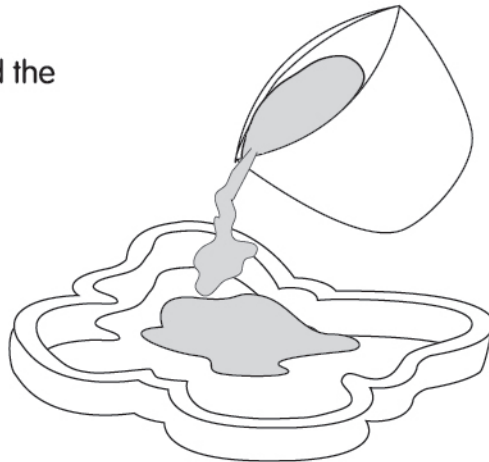
Lift the mould, and carefully tap onto the work surface a few times to remove air bubbles until the cement levels out.

Wash the mixing bowl and spatula immediately with water outside. Never rinse down the sink- as it can build up and clog your drains.

#### Helpful Tips:

If a thin layer of water forms on the surface of the stone, absorb it with a paper towel (once) and wait a little longer to begin decorating with mosaics.

Temperature can affect setting time- If it's cool and damp, add a little less water and expect the mixture to set slower. If it's hot and dry, add a little more water and expect the mixture to set faster. Too much water will slow the setting time.



**STEP 4.** Decorate your stone with the mosaic pieces and rhinestones. Push each piece gently in to the cement, until it is level with the surface of the cement. Leave a little space in between each mosaic piece. Use the front of the box as an example or create your own design!

Wait at least 24 hours for the stone to dry. Drying times may vary- make sure the cement feels dry before removing from the mould!

If you remove it too early it may crack.



Colours of components may vary.

Adult supervision required.
