

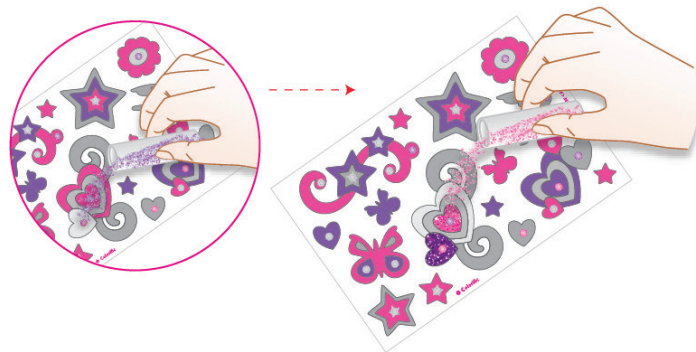
Glitter Jewellery Fashion

Create glitter body tattoos

- 1 Select a hard, flat surface to work on. Place down some newspaper to protect your workspace. Take the sticker sheet and choose a design. Peel off the sections of a single colour one at a time. Take some gems and stick them to the design however you like. You can follow the designs of the sticker sheet or create your own.



- 2 Take a glitter tube and carefully sprinkle the colour evenly over the sticky parts (the same colour as the single sticker you removed from step 1). Brush away excess glitter. Repeat steps 1-2 with all colours of the design. Keep the glitter away from furniture and carpet.



- 3 Once your design is completed peel off the body sticker from the sheet, then place them on your arms, hands, shoulders, legs or feet. Watch them sparkle! Repeat steps 1-3 for all the designs. To remove, simply peel away the sticker from your skin.



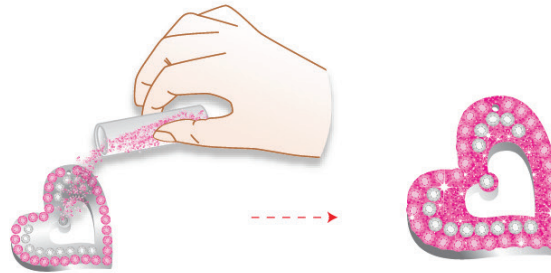

Create glitter pendant necklaces

- 1 Choose one of the three pendants and peel off the pink sticker. Take some gems and stick them to the pendant however you like, without blocking the holes on the pendant. You can follow the designs shown on the front of the box or create your own. Repeat for the other pendants.



- 2 Take a glitter tube and carefully sprinkle evenly over the sticky parts. Brush away the excess glitter. Keep the glitter away from furniture and carpet. Repeat for the other pendants.



- 3 Cut the beading twine in half so you have two 1 metre lengths. Thread the pendant into the middle of the twine and tie two tight knots. Decide how long you would like your necklace to be and cut the twine to the desired length. For best results do not cut the total length of twine any smaller than 40cm long, as your necklace needs to fit over your head.



- 4 Thread on any combination of beads however you like. You can follow the designs on the front of the box or create your own. After you have finished beading your necklace, tie the two ends of the twine together with two tight knots.



Create glitter bangles

- 1 Take the pink sticker sheet and choose a design. Peel off the top paper layer. Take some gems and stick them to the design however you like.



- 2 Take a glitter tube and carefully sprinkle the colour evenly over the sticky parts. Brush away excess glitter. Keep the glitter away from furniture and carpet.



- 3 Carefully peel and stick the glittered design onto your bangle. Repeat steps 1-3, until you have decorated both bangles.

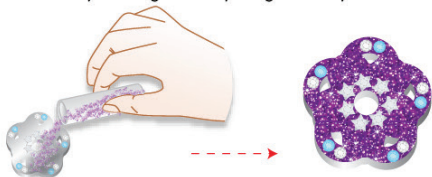


Create a glitter braided bracelet

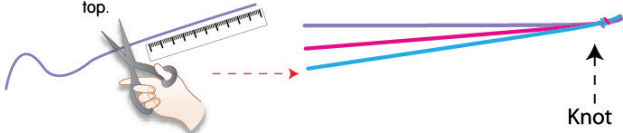
- 1 Take the flower pendant and peel off the pink sticker. Take some gems and stick them to the pendant however you like without blocking the holes on the pendant. You can follow the designs of the sticker sheet or create your own.



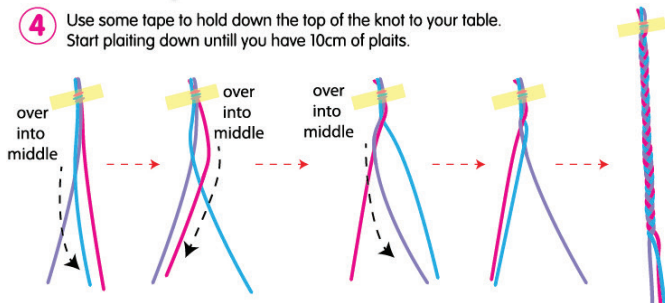
- 2 Take a glitter tube and carefully sprinkle evenly over the sticky parts. Brush away excess glitter. Keep the glitter away from furniture and carpet.



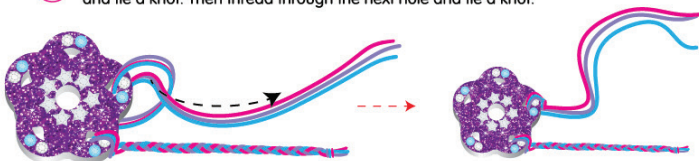
- 3 Choose your colour combination to make the plaited bands for your bracelet. Cut three lengths of 30cm thread and tie them together with a knot at the top.



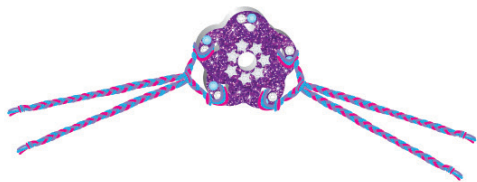
- 4 Use some tape to hold down the top of the knot to your table. Start plaiting down until you have 10cm of plaits.



- 5 Loop the end of the plait through one of the holes in the pendant and tie a knot. Then thread through the next hole and tie a knot.

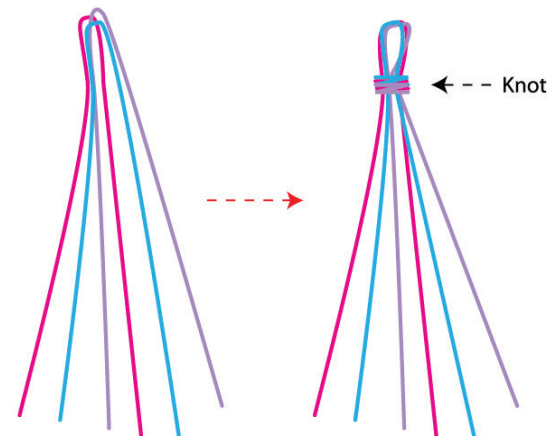
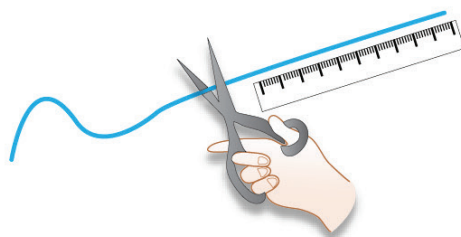


- 6 Continue to plait 10cm, then tie a knot at the end. Take your two plaits and tie a double knot. Repeat steps 1-6 for the other side of the bracelet.

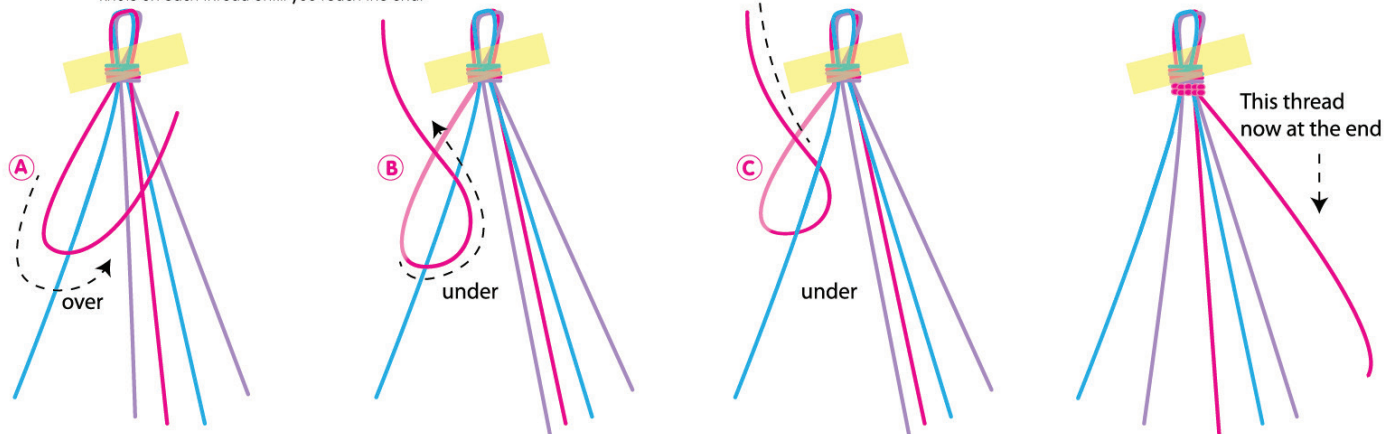


Create braided friendship bracelets

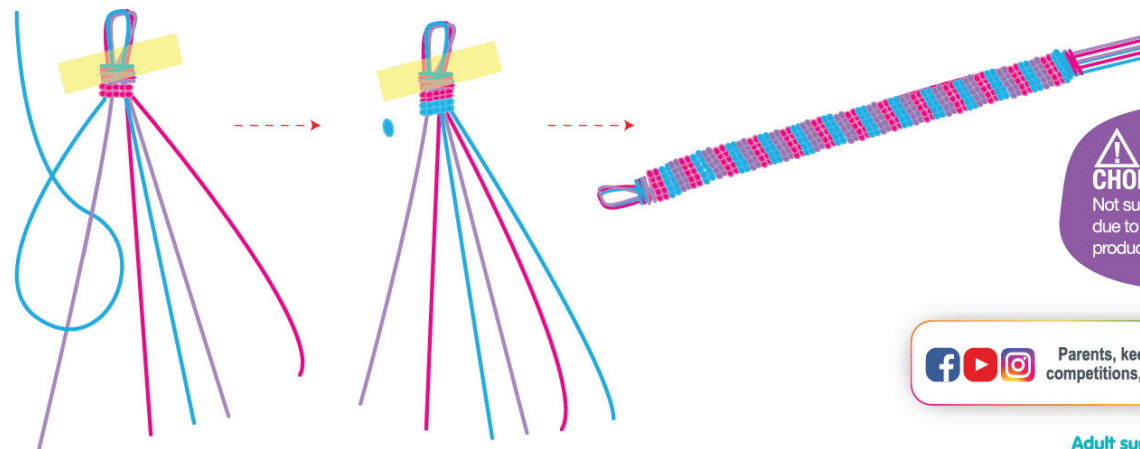
- 1 Choose your colour combination, you can use two or three colours. For three colours cut 1.6 metre of thread. For two colours cut 1.3 metre of thread. Fold the threads in half and tie a knot at the folded end.



- 2 Use some tape to hold the knot down on your table.
 - A Take the first piece of thread and loop over the second thread.
 - B Then go under the second thread and through the loop.
 - C Pull up gently to create the knot. Do not make the knots too tight. Repeat A-C to create a second knot. Keep making the same coloured knots on each thread until you reach the end.



- 3 Take the first thread and make two knots. Keep creating two knots on each thread until you reach the end. Repeat for the other coloured threads. Continue braiding until the first thread now is at the end and your bracelet is long enough to fit your wrist. Once your bracelet is at the correct length, tie a tight knot to finish. Make some to give to your BFFs!
