

# MAKE YOUR OWN

# WHAT'S INSIDE?



- Wooden hanging rod
- · 6 Wooden beads
- . 500g Air dry clay
- · Wooden picture frame
- 15 Wooden pegs
- 3 Clay sculpting tools
- · 50 Sticky foam squares · 3 Tassels
- 7 Wooden icons
- · Black string(15m)



You will need; Scissors / Hanging Hook or screw





You will need to cut your string with a pair of scissors (not included)


Start by cutting 3 lengths of string (150cm each)using the measuring graphic on the bottom of this page. Also cut a length of 70cm string These lengths will make a total Photo Wall display 98cm x Width 47cm. You may wish to cut to your own desired lengths.

# 2. THREADIN G & WRAPPING

A. Carefully thread the 3 x 150cm lengths into the holes on the hanging rod labelled (A). Tie them off with a double knot. Tip: Wet the string ends if they become frayed and hard to thread.



Closely loop the string around the hanging rod from one end to the other. Ensure the existing lengths of string are left out and uncovered as above. Cut off any excess string and tuck in the ends.

Carefully thread the 70cm length cut string into the hole labelled B), this will form the hanging triangle. Tie it off with a double knot through the other hole labeled (C).



Find a large plate to work your clay on. Open your bag of clay and roll out 6 round portions. Keep your clay on a Tip. The clay will start to dry within minutes of being removed



Using the inside card roll from the black string, roll out the clay portions into round discs. The discs should be around 10cm in



Choose a clay tool and cut your discs into any shapes you like. Refer to the final image over the page for clay shape inspirations.



**WRAPPING AFTER** 

TYING A KNOT AT

THIS END.

Use the edging on one of your tools to create some patterns on your clay shapes.



Poke 2 holes in the shapes with your pointy tool to allow the string to pass through. Allow 24hrs to dry or until it feels dry

# 4. LET'S BUILD IT!

IT'S A GOOD IDEA TO PLAN AHEAD AND THINK **ABOUT WHERE YOU WANT TO CONNECT YOUR DECORATIONS BEFORE TYING OFF THE KNOTS.** THIS IS ONLY AN EXAMPLE OF HOW YOU COULD LAY EVERYTHING OUT, YOU CAN DESIGN YOUR PHOTO WALL ANY WAY YOU LIKE.

### **WOODEN ICONS.**

Choose your fave icons and thread the string through the two holes to fasten them in place.




### **CLAY SHAPES.**

After making and allowing your clay shapes to dry, carefully thread the string through the 2 holes.



### TASSELS

Tie the tassels onto the ends of your three strings once you have threaded or attached all the decorations you want.



### **WOODEN PEGS**

Attach your photos to the string using your wooden



### **WOODEN PHOTO FRAME.**

Your photo should be no smaller than 10cm x 15cm. The frame can be positioned either Portrait or landscape style.



Place the sticky foam squares around the opening of the frame hole as above. The foam squares should be stuck on the non patterned side of the

The string will run through the 2 holes on the back which will hold in position.

### **WOODEN BEADS.**

Thread your beads up to the desired position then tie a knot to keep them in place. Alternately you can tie a knot underneath the bottom hole.
